for the International MA Programme in East European Jewish Studies

Guidelines

One of the priorities of the Department of Jewish Studies is to create an attractive studentship offer to support our students' academic development. Our studentships for EEJS students are designed to provide financial aid to students throughout the duration of the Programme.

Deadline for submitting applications for financial aid: **9 September, 2022**.

Form: electronic

The application: a cover letter detailing the candidate's most important academic achievements to date, further academic plans, and any other information that the candidate deems relevant. A letter of recommendation from an academic advisor or professor would be helpful where possible.

Announcement of awarded financial aid: 16 September, 2022 via email.

The studentship committee is composed of Prof. Wojciech Tworek (head), Prof. Agnieszka Jagodzińska, and Prof. Karolina Szymaniak. The committee will award the studentship and announce it on the designated date.

2) € 550 per semester for three semesters (€ 1,650 in total)

This studentship is available to EU citizens who did not receive the other scholarship (\leqslant 3300), and to applicants from non-EU countries whether they received the other studentship or not.

Payment method: the scholarship will be paid in PLN to the student's account in 3 installments (in November, March, and November) based on the BNP currency exchange rate of 19 September, 2022.

Additional conditions: failure to complete the semester and / or excessive violation of University regulations will result in the withdrawal of the studentship offer.
